### 78/2017: Report of the Clerk:

- (a) Car Parks: Somercotes Market Place Lights: A quote for £396 ex VAT has been received from M Kemp to install 2 x 30w LED PIR Security Floodlights using the existing feed from the light at the back of the Curry Lounge building. The Proprietor of the Curry Lounge has agreed that the lights may be fixed to the building. He has also offered a donation of £50 towards the installation cost. The supporting document illustrates the type of lights which are proposed.
- **(b)** Christmas Lights The Councils Christmas lights are beginning to look tired and dated. No replacement programme is currently in place. The cost of replacing the lights in their entirety is prohibitive; being in the region of £30000. Councillors may wish to consider spreading this cost by adopting a replacement programme or allocating a restricted reserve account for a phased replacement. See Item 78(e) below.
- **(c) Meadow Area** There is a grassed area between the Winding Wheel and Seely Terrace which is currently maintained by the parish wardens. A suggestion has been made that the area may be suitable for creating a wild flower and grass area. The initial quotes for the laying of a meadow mat range from £780 £1250. However, it is possible that building debris is beneath the grass which would require removing before the mat could be laid. The costs for this work are presently unknown and Councilors may also wish to consider the visual impacts which may result from cutting the area once per year as is recommended for some varieties. See supporting document.
