- 13/2012: Clerk's Report
  - a) Newsletter: Next edition is being finalised for distribution in February. Now that there is suitable material and a programme for producing the newsletter 4 magazines per annum can be produced.
  - b) Carol Service: The Carol Service collection raised £144.00
  - c) Parish Council Calendar: These have all been sold and an excellent response has been received on the quality and picture content. It is proposed, with the Council's approval, to produce a calendar for printing in August so early sales will maximise sales.
