04/2023.24: Public Speaking – (30 minutes)

The attendant members of the public expressed their objections to the planning application AVA/2023/0059 (Birchwood Riding School). Their objections included:

- The area was overdeveloped 800 houses were already planned.
- The loss of green space.
- Inadequate infrastructure for the proposal (schools, doctors, roads etc)
- Concerns regarding air pollution
- Council were informed that a local resident had experienced ill health which could be linked to the effects of pollution.

Council considered the matters raised and RESOLVED:

- a. To include the objections raised in the councils response
- b. To write to the resident with health problems and seek permission to obtain a copy of the hospital discharge notice.

05/2023.24: Council response to AVA/2023/0059 - Birchwood Riding Centre

Council considered the application and **RESOLVED** to submit a consultation response containing the matters raised by residents at Item 04/2023.24 above in additional to the following concerns:

- Whether S106 funding would be spent in Somercotes
- That the proposed access and egress from the highway to the site were unsuitable as it was a minor road with speed and weight restrictions.
- That the number of houses planned were too many for the site area.
- The development further decimated the flora and fauna in the area including protected species of badgers and bats.
- Loss of local leisure facilities.
- Close proximity to historical waste sites
- Proven leachate from those sites.
- The area has the sixth worst air quality in Derbyshire according to research commissioned by the Department for Levelling Up, Housing & Communities. Additional traffic can only increase this pollution.
- The possible link between pollution and ill health as identified in the public speaking comments.
